Sailing crew tickets will only be issued when racing fee is paid

Flag officers may be allocated additional tickets and may issue these visitor tickets at their discretion

Kids under the age of 13 are free.

One ticket per person and a ticket is only valid for one night.

Boat Stickers

Have any members noticed the number of boats parked up near the gate??? We don't know who these boats belong to and they have, therefore, not been charged for.

With effect from 1 May 2011 members will be required to display their boat registration / license disc sticker on their boats. The sticker will only be issued if boat fees are paid in full.

No boat will be allowed to launch without the license disc sticker displayed.

The color of the license disc will change each year and a new sticker will be issued each year.

The disc is to be stuck onto the rear starboard side (right rear) of the boat.

Sign out book at the Gantry
