

Sail the 60th annual race to smash our Guinness World Record™!

Calling all sailors to make South African sailing history! It's the Diamond Jubilee of the 'LDYC Round-the-Island Race'. Let's celebrate by breaking our international Guinness World Record™ awarded in 2007, when 389 boats crossed the finish line.

It's not only guts and glory. There are cash prizes totalling R30,000 across several categories and over 65 trophies to win. On Sunday, dinghy sailors may choose to race either the full course or the shorter 'Beat to Beacon Island' challenge.

The fleet will also fight against pollution. A donation from every race entry fee will be given to SAVE (Save our Vaal Environment) committed to fighting the poisoning of the Vaal Dam and River waterways.

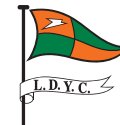
