NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The SA Sailing prescriptions for National and Regional Championships will not apply.
- 1.3 All yachts shall conform to the safety requirements and regulations as laid down by SA Sailing.
- 1.4 All yachts over 9 meters shall be in possession of a valid COF certificate.
- 1.5 At least one person on board all yachts over 9 meters shall be in possession of a valid skipper's ticket.
- 1.6 A working cell phone contact number must be supplied on the entry form.
- 1.7 Race communication on VHF Channel 9.
- 1.8 This event does not have controlled event status and as such all skippers must ensure that they and their yachts conform to SAS requirements.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on 5 January 2025, at LDYC Notice Board for all classes as well as on the LDYC website.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at LDYC as well as on the official WhatsApp group.
- 3.2 All boats may carry a marine VHF radio capable of communicating on 9 and 16. Official race channel shall be 9.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY



- 4.1 The regatta is open to all classes of keelboats, micro multihulls, catamarans and dinghies.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and submitting it, together with the fee, to **LDYC** by **25th January 2025**, registering online at www.windsail.co.za.
- 4.3 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
- 4.4 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: **5th February 2025** by **12:00** latest
- 4.5 All competitors need not be members in good standing of SA Sailing and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete.

7.2.2 9 February 2025 - L.D.Y.C Round the Island Race – First signal not before 07h25

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: **Based on the entries received** and included in the annual Round the Island prize giving.

9 RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone." Competitors participate in this event entirely at their own risk. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

10 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of **R20,000** per incident or the equivalent.
