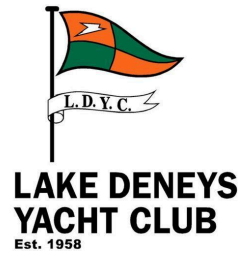


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NOTICE TO MEMBERS

Dear Member

Please be advised that the elected Rear Commodore resigned his portfolio during March 2024.

In terms of 27.10 of the constitution:

In the event of additional MANCOM resignations where MANCOM is unable to elect a successor from the existing MANCOM members. MANCOM may temporarily appoint any fully paid-up ordinary member/s who is entitled to vote at General Meetings and who is eligible to be elected as an officer on committees. The temporary appointment must be ratified by a vote of the members at a Special General meeting, convened for that purpose, within three months of the temporary appointment or the next Annual General meeting, provided the same is within three months of the appointment.

The annual general meeting is scheduled, within three months requirement of 27.10, to be held in May 2024 and this appointment will be subject to nominations as received.

There are many reasons why a club, run by volunteers, should receive nominations from members to volunteer for the various profiles of the committees and the management committee that are required to lead the club.

- To ensure that the club is run by a diverse group of people with a variety of skills and perspectives. Through nominations, the membership can ensure that they have a broad range of people involved in decision-making.
- To give members a sense of ownership and investment in the club. This hopefully leads to increased participation and support from members, this is essential for the long-term health of the club.
- To identify and develop new leaders. Members can embrace volunteer positions, while the club can pinpoint and nurture emerging leaders for the future.
- To build community. Volunteering is a great way to build relationships and create a sense of community among club members. Building a more positive and supportive club environment for all members.

Calling for nominations for members to volunteer for the various profiles of the sub-committees and management committee that are required to run the club; is an important way to ensure that the club is run effectively and efficiently, and that it is a positive and supportive environment for all members.

NOMINATIONS FOR MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (MANCOM) FOR 2024/2025

As per Clause 31 of the Club Constitution:

26. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meetings shall have the following attributes: -

- 26.1. The Annual General Meeting of the Club shall be held in or about May of each year.
- 26.3. Twenty-one days' notice of such meeting shall be sent to every member with full agenda and posted on the Club notice board.

Extracts from Clause 27 of the Club Constitution:

- 27.1 MANCOM shall be elected each year. No person may be elected to more than one position on MANCOM unless this occurs as a result of the application of the provisions of sub-Article 26.8.
- 27.2 Nominations for the Committee shall be in writing, shall be signed by the Nominator, Secunder and the Nominee, and shall be lodged with the Club Secretary by not later than 14 days prior to the Annual General Meeting at which the election is to take place. All nominations shall be displayed on the Club Notice Board for not less than fourteen days prior to the said Annual General meeting. Only Ordinary members and Honorary Life members shall be eligible to nominate or second Committee members.
- 27.3 Candidates nominated for MANCOM shall be fully paid up members for the current year and shall be proposed and seconded in writing by two members of the club and counter-signed by the candidate himself, signifying his acceptance of the commitments of his office and those entered into in good faith by the outgoing MANCOM, and shall be placed in the hands of the Secretary one hour before the Annual General Meeting.
- 27.4 At the close of the nominations, a complete list shall be posted on the notice board in the clubhouse.
- 27.5 If the number of persons nominated does not exceed the total number to be elected, the members so nominated shall, at the Annual General Meeting, be formally declared as elected for a period of one year.
- 27.6 If the number of candidates nominated exceeds the number of vacancies, the election shall be by ballot.
- 27.7 Nominations may be made at the Annual General Meeting, but only if insufficient nominations to fill the vacancies have been made in proper time.
