



NOTICE OF RACE

2025 LDYC Easter Regatta

- Dates** : 18th April 2025 to 21st April 2025
- Venue** : LAKE DENEYS YACHT CLUB (LDYC) – VAAL DAM
- Organising Authority** : LAKE DENEYS YACHT CLUB (LDYC)

1. RULES

- 1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2025-2028).
- 1.2. This event does not have controlled event status, and as such, all skippers must ensure that they and their yachts conform to the National Small Vessels Safety Regulations.
- 1.3. All yachts over 9 meters shall be in possession of a valid COF certificate.
- 1.4. At least one person on board all yachts over 9 meters shall be in possession of a valid skippers' ticket.
- 1.5. A working cell phone contact number must be supplied on the entry form.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board and on WhatsApp no later than 18H00 30th March 2025.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located at LDYC and will also be posted to the race WhatsApp group.

- 3.3. A VHF radio capable of receiving and transmitting on Channel 9 and/ or Channel 16 may be monitored at all times during the event whilst boats are away from their moorings for those vessels wishing to monitor VHF.



4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The race is open to all keel boats, micro-multihulls, dinghy and catamaran classes.
- 4.2. Each participating class to be scored individually:
 - Sport Boats with a handicap of 1.00 and above
 - Racing fleet with any handicap
 - Non-spinnaker with any handicap
 - Catamaran with any handicap

- Dinghy with any handicap.
- 4.3. Eligible boats may enter online at www.windsail.co.za and submitting it, together with the fee, to LDYC office before the race.
 - 4.4. To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.
 - 4.5. All skippers shall be members in good standing of SA Sailing and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete.
 - 4.6. Except in the Single-handed classes and in events whose instructions specify contrary, a minimum of two persons shall be aboard a yacht.
 - 4.7. The Organizing Authority shall have the right but, not the obligation, to refuse entry to any yacht it deems to be unfit for this event.

5. SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

Notwithstanding any class and SAMSA requirements, all keelboats shall carry the following minimum safety Equipment:

- Minimum two litres fresh water, at all times.
- Minimum one in-service fire extinguisher.
- One anchor suitable for the size of boat, together with chain and min' 20m- length of chain for Vessels >6m = 5m Chain; Vessels < 6m =3m chain; Length of warp – at least 50 m
- Serviceable inboard or outboard motor.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of R200 000 (Two Hundred Thousand Rand) per incident or the equivalent.

- 12.1. Courtesy moorings marked orange will be available, on request, at LDYC for visiting yachts.
- 12.2. Camping for competitors and their families is free for the entire weekend.
- 12.3. Bar and Restaurant facilities will be provided throughout the weekend.
